



Trick or Treat

Aims:

- To revise some of the activities previously introduced in 'Stamp over October'

Resources:

- stamps
- glue
- paper or card
- on paper stamps
- bowl of water
- envelope
- coloured pens or pencils

Activity:

Do all three of these activities:

1. Dooking for stamps – Instead of dooking for apples (or apple bobbing) then soak some stamps off their paper. However don't pick the stamps out with your mouth or fork!
2. Carve your pumpkin with stamps – Instead of carving a real pumpkin or turnip create a collage of a pumpkin with stamps.
3. Design a Halloween cover – Instead of a costume, design a cover (special envelope) for Halloween. Decorate the envelope and design a suitable postmark.



Trick or Treat Draw
